RUMOR HAS IT, THE XO IS NOW TRYING TO LINE UP A SMALL BOAT TRANSFER IN A STATE SEVEN SEA.

CHICAGO-- POLICE ARE KEEPING WATCH AT THE CHICAGO FUNERAL CHAPEL HOUSING THE BODY OF JACK RUBY FOLLOWING SEVERAL CALLS CONCERNING THE MAN WHO KILLED ACCUSED PRESIDENTIAL ASSASSIN LEE OSWALD. PRIVATE FUNERAL SERVICES WILL BE HELD TOMORROW. THE 55-YEAR-OLD RUBY DIED TUESDAY IN A DALLAS, TEXAS HOSPITAL OF EXTENSIVE CANCER AND A BLOOD CLOT.

A FORMER ATTORNEY FOR RUBY SAYS HE BELIEVES RUBY'S SURVIVORS WILL FILE A DAMAGE SUIT ALLEGING NEGLECT BY DALLAS COUNTY OFFICERS. JOE TONAHILL SAYS COMPLAINTS BY RUBY'S RELATIVES OVER HIS TREATMENT IN JAIL APPEAR TO BE A PRELUDE TO SUCH A SUIT.

SNOW STORMS ARE REPORTED IN THE EASTERN, WESTERN AND MIDDLE SECTIONS OF THE NATION. WARNINGS TO MOTORISTS AND STOCKMEN FOR HEAVY SNOW REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR THE MONTANA MOUNTAINS. GALE WARNINGS ARE POSTED FOR THE COASTAL AREAS OF NEW ENGLAND, WITH HEAVY SNOW WARNINGS FOR PORTIONS OF MAINE. AND ANOTHER DISBURBANCE IS PRODUCING SNOW IN PARTS OF WISCONSIN AND INDIANA.

GROUND WAR ACTION IN SOUTH VIETNAM CONTINUES IN A GENERAL LULL WITH ONLY MINOR FIGHTS REPORTED. HOWEVER, U-S PILOTS HAVE BEEN QUITE ACTIVE, AND NAVY PILOTS REPORT TWO CARRIER PLANES WERE LOST TO ENEMY GROUND FIRE YESTERDAY JUST OFF THE NORTH VIETNAMESE COAST. THE AIRMEN WERE RESCUED. NAVY PILOTS ALSO REPORT DESTROYING OR DAMAGING 188 NORTH VIETNAMESE SUPPLY BARGES AND JUNKS DURING TWO DAYS OF RAIDS OFF THE NORTH VIETNAM COAST.

TWO AMERICAN CIVILIANS WHO WERE HELD PRISONERS BY THE VIET CONG FOR SEVEN MONTHS TOLD NEWSMEN OF THEIR ORDEAL TODAY AT A MILITARY HOSPITAL IN LONG BINH, VIETNAM. THOMAS SCALES AND ROBERT MONAHAN SAID THEY GOT BAD FOOD BUT WERE NOT MISTREATED, SANG SONGS FOR THE COMMUNISTS, WERE GIVEN A CHRISTMAS PARTY AND WERE ALMOST KILLED BY A U-S AIR RAID.

SCALES, WHO IS 44 AND FROM MATOMORAS, PENNSYLVANIA AND MONAHAN, WHO IS 41 AND FROM BELLPORT, LONG ISLAND, WERE FOUND NEAR SAIGON AFTER BEING RELEASED BY THE VIET CONG.

THEY SAID THE VIET CONG TOLD THEM THEY WERE RELEASED BECAUSE THEY FINALLY HAD SHOWN REPENTANCE. SCALES TOLD NEWSMEN, HOWEVER, THEY DON'T KNOW WHAT THEY REPENTED FOR. THE MEN, EMPLOYES OF A CONSTRUCTION FIRM, SAID THEY WERE ALWAYS GUARDED, BUT NOT MISTREATED. THEY SAID THE VIET CONG WERE ALWAYS COMPLIMENTING THEM FOR THEIR CHEERFUL ATTITUDE, AND EVEN GAVE THEM MOLASSES, PEANUTS AND TOBACCO FOR A CHRISTMAS PARTY.

HARLEM CONGRESSMAN ADAM CLAYTON POWELL HAS ISSUED A BLISTERING ATTACK ON THOSE TRYING TO OUST HIM AS CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE EDUCATION AND LABOR COMMITTEE. THE NEW YORK DEMOCRAT, A NEGRO, SAYS IT'S A POLITICAL CONSPIRACY AIMED AT U-S- NEGROES. AND HE PROMISES AN ALL OUT FIGHT TO KEEP HIS CHAIRMANSHIP. THE QUESTION OF HIS CHAIRMANSHIP SHOULD BE SETTLED IN THE DEMOCRATIC CAUCUS MONDAY--ONE DAY BEFORE THE 90TH CONGRESS CONVENES.

AMERICAN SOLDIERS IN VIETNAM WILL SOON HAVE A NEW WEAPONS SYSTEM AT THEIR DISPOSAL. IT'S CALLED A HUEYCOBRA HELICOPTER, WHICH HAS A CAPABILITY TO FIRE 400 GRENADES PER MINUTE AND UP TO 3,000 MACHINES GUN ROUNDS PER MINUTE AT THE SAME TIME. THE FIRST 90 COBRAS ARE TO ARRIVE IN VIETNAM LATER THIS YEAR.

AMERICAN VIETNAM WAR CASUALTIES INCREASED LAST WEEK WHILE SOUTH VIETNAMESE AND COMMUNIST CASUALTIES DECREASED. U-S OFFICIALS IN SAIGON SAY 128 AMERICAN SOLDIERS WERE KILLED LAST WEEK, WHICH INCLUDED 48 HOURS OF HOLIDAY CEASE-FIRE. THE REPORT RAISES THE UNOFFICIAL TOTAL OF AMERICAN KILLED COMBAT IN THE WAR TO 6,644.

THERE'S STILL NO DEFINITE WORD ON THE LANDING PLACE OF AN UNARMED U-S MISSILE THAT WENT ASTRAY TODAY. THE PENTAGON FIGURES THAT IT PROBABLY LANDED IN THE CARIBBEAN ABOUT 100 MILES SOUTH OF CUBA'S SOUTHWEST COAST--AFTER FLYING OVER FIDEL CASTRO'S ISLAND. THE 650-MILE-AN-HOUR "MACE" ROCKET HAD BEEN FIRED FROM EGLIN AIR FORCE BASE IN FLORIDA AS A DRONE TARGET FOR F-FOUR PHANTOM JETS.

THE SOUTH VIETNAMESE GOVERNMENT HAS ANNOUNCED IT WILL FREE SOME NORTH VIETNAMESE PRISONERS--NO WORD ON JUST HOW MANY--AT THE START OF THE LUNAR NEW YEAR IN FEBRUARY. THE SAIGON GOVERNMENT SAID THE PRISONERS WILL BE GIVEN THEIR CHOICE BETWEEN RETURNING TO THE NORTH OR STAYING IN THE SOUTH. LAST YEAR, 24 PRISONERS WERE SET FREE--AND THREE DECIDED TO STAY IN SOUTH VIETNAM.

THE VIET CONG RELEASED TWO AMERICAN CONSTRUCTION MEN AND A FILIPINA-BORN WOMAN THEY HAD SEIZED MORE THAN SIX MONTHS AGO. THE WOMAN'S HUSBAND IS SAID TO HAVE DIED IN PRISON SIX DAYS AGO.

#### IN OTHER DEVELOPMENTS INVOLVING VIETNAM TODAY:

THE NORTH VIETNAMESE CLAIM THREE US PLANES WERE SHOT DOWN OVER THEIR TERRITORY TODAY. THERE'S NO U-S CONFIRMATION.

THERE WERE NEW INCIDENTS OF GUERRILLA TERRORISM IN SOUTH VIETNAM, WITH A TOTAL OF THREE MEN KILLED.

IN WASHINGTON, PRESIDENTIAL NEWS SECRETARY BILL MOYERS SAID HE HAD NO EVIDENCE TO INDICATE THAT HANOI WOULD RECIPROCATE ANY SUCH GESTURE AS A HALT IN US BOMBINGS OF NORTH VIETNAM.

RADIO CITY MUSIC HALL IN NEW YORK EXPECTS TO WELCOME TOMORROW THE 200 MIL. 10TH CUSTOMER TO ENTER THE HUGH THEATER SINCE IT OPENED ON DECEMBER 27TH, 1932. THE MANAGEMENT SAYS IT THINKS THIS IS A MARK NEVER REACHED BY ANY OTHER THEATER ANYWHERE. AND PUBLIC RELATIONS DIRECTOR ED SPRLIN SAYS APPROPRIATE CEREMONIES ARE PLANNED.

ACTOR LEE MARVIN'S WIFE HAS WON A DEFAULT DIVORCE IN SANTA MONICA, CALIFORNIA. MARVIN WAS ORDERED TO PAY HER \$6,000 A MONTH ALIMONY AND \$1,000 A MONTH FOR SUPPORT OF THEIR FOUR CHILDREN, RANGING IN AGE FROM EIGHT TO 16 YEARS. MARVIN WON AN ACADEMY AWARD FOR HIS ROLE AS A DRUNKEN GUNSLINGER IN THE 1965 MOVIE "CAT BALLOU"

TRAFFIC DEATHS IN 1966 APPEAR TO HAVE SET A NEW RECORD. THE NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL SAYS NO FINAL COUNT OF LAST YEAR'S DEATHS WILL BE AVAILABLE UNTIL LATE JANUARY OR FEBRUARY. SOME SAY THE COUNT COULD BE ABOVE 52,000. THE RECORD IS 49,000 DEATHS, SET IN 1965.

RESCUE TEAMS WILL TRY TO REACH A COLORADO MOUNTAIN SIDE TODAY WHERE FIVE PERSONS ARE BELIEVED TO HAVE SURVIVED A PLANE CRASH. ARMY HELICOPTERS AND SNOW VEHICLES WILL TRY TO LAND THE RESCUERS ON PEAK OF 14,000-FOOT MOUNT SHERMAN, 100 MILES SOUTHWEST OF DENVER.

NO DEATHS ARE REPORTED IN A MAJOR EARTHQUAKE WHICH ROCKED CENTRAL MONGOLIA TODAY. THE MONGOLIAN NEWS AGENCY SAYS THE QUAKE REGISTERED NINE ON A 12-POINT SCALE AND WAS CENTERED NEAR A THINLY POPULATED MOUNTAIN REGION. THE MONGOLIAN AGENCY SAID THE QUAKE WAS CENTERED 180 MILES NORTHWEST OF ULAN BATOR, THE CAPITAL. THERE IS NO REPORT OF DAMAGE IN THE CAPITAL. THE GENERAL REGION OF TODAY'S QUAKE WAS SHAKEN IN 1957 BY ONE OF THE MOST POWERFUL EARTHQUAKES IN MODERN HISTORY IN WHICH 1,2000 PERSONS WERE KILLED.

A STRIKE THREATENED FOR THIS MORNING BY ABOUT 650 TEACHERS AT EIGHT JUNIOR COLLEGES IN CHICAGO HAS BEEN POSTPONED FOR AT LEAST ONE DAY-- REPORTEDLY ON A PROMISE OF MORE MONEY. FURTHER NEGOTIATIONS ARE SCHEDULED FOR TODAY. MEANWHILE, THE THREAT OF A WALKOUT BY CHICAGO ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS APPEARS TO BE GAINING MOMENTUM. A SPOKESMAN SAYS THE CHICAGO TEACHERS UNION MAY SET A STRIKE DATE AT A MEETING TONIGHT IN THEIR BATTLE FOR A \$1,000 PAY HIKE FOR 1967.

POLICE IN VIGEVANO, ITALY SAY THEY'VE TURNED UP AN UNUSUAL BICYCLE THIEF. THEY IDENTIFY HIM AS DEDALO GRIFFINI AND SAY THIS WAS HIS METHOD OF OPERATION. HE WOULD TAKE A BUS FROM MILAN TO VEGEVANO, WHERE MANY PEOPLE OWN BIKES. STEAL ONE AND PEDAL BACK THE 25 MILES TO MILAN. THERE GRIFFINI WOULD SELL THE BIKE FOR A FEW DOLLARS. WHAT POLICE FOUND MORE UNUSUAL THAN HIS STRENUOUS METHOD OF THEFT IS GRIFFINI'S AGE: 71.

IN NEW YORK, THE WIDOW OF AN EXECUTIVE WHO EARNED \$28,500 A YEAR HAS BEEN AWARDED WIDOW'S COMPENSATION OF \$36 A WEEK FOR LIFE. THE AWARD TO MRS. LAWRENCE BURMAN WAS MADE ON THE GROUND THAT HIS MURDER LAST AUGUST BY A FELLOW EMPLOYEE WAS AN ACCIDENT OF EMPLOYMENT.

(JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA)--A NEW STUDY OF THE RELATIONSHIP OF CIGARETTE SMOKING TO LUNG CANCER WAS REPORTED TODAY TO SHOW THAT A SMOKER GETS A GREATLY INCREASED AMOUNT OF TAR AND NICOTINE IF HE SMOKES DOWN TO THE LAST PUFFS.

DR. E. CUYLER HAMMOND OF NEW YORK CITY, STATISTICAL VICE PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY, ANNOUNCED THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY IN JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA, AS THE SOCIETY STAGED THE PREMIERE OF AN ANIMATED COLOR FILM, "A TIME FOR DECISION."

HAMMOND SAID RESEARCH SHOWED THAT THE LONGER THE FILTER, THE LESS OF THE TOTAL CIGARETTE IS SMOKED.

HOWEVER, HAMMOND ADDED, THE INTAKE OF TARS AND NICOTINE INCREASES AS THE BURNING TIP NEARS THE FILTER. THE DOCTOR SAID:

"THE LAST PUFF OF A FILTER CIGARETTE IS ACTUALLY STRONGER THAN THE FIRST PUFF OF A NON-FILTER CIGARETTE."

HE SAID THE HOT TIP VAPORIZES TARS ALREADY CONDENSED IN THE TOBACCO AS THE SMOKE PASSES THROUGH. HAMMOND ADDED:

"SMOKING A CIGARETTE AN ADDITIONAL QUARTER OF AN INCH--DOWN TO THE LAST PUFF--PRODUCES AN ADDITIONAL 30 PER CENT OF TAR IN THE LAST PUFF."

HAMMOND SAID THE STUDY WAS CONDUCTED IN NEW YORK CITY BY COLLECTING CIGARETTE BUTTS FROM ASH TRAYS OF MIDDLE CLASS HOMES.

HAMMOND EMPHASIZED THAT A RECOMMENDATION TO THROW AWAY CIGARETTE BEFORE TAKING THE LAST PUFF DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A RECOMMENDATION TO SMOKE. RATHER HE SAID, IT IS A MEANS OF REDUCING THE DANGER TO THE HEALTH OF THOSE WHO DO SMOKE.

THE TOBACCO INDUSTRY HAS SAID ANY CONNECTION BETWEEN CIGARETTE SMOKING AND CANCER IS UNPROVEN.

THERE WAS AN UNCONFIRMED RUMOR ON WALL STREET LATE TODAY THAT PRESIDENT JOHNSON IS NOT GOING TO ASK FOR A TAX INCREASE. TRADING HAD BEEN SLACK MOST OF THE DAY, BUT THE RUMOR BROUGHT A SURGE OF BUYING AND FINAL VOLUME WAS SIX MILLION 150 THOUSAND SHARES. THE DOW JONES AVERAGE OF 30 INDUSTRIALS CLOSED AT 791.14--UP 4.73. THE ASSOCIATED PRESS AVERAGE OF 60 STOCKS WAS UP 1.9 AT 294.7.

SENATE DEMOCRATIC LEADER MIKE MANSFIELD SAYS HE EXPECTS THE PRESIDENT TO CARRY OUT HIS ANNOUNCED INTENTION OF TRIMMING DOMESTIC SPENDING BY THREE AND ONE-HALF BILLION DOLLARS BETWEEN NOW AND JUNE 30TH. AND MANSFIELD PREDICTED THAT JOHNSON WILL LIMIT HIS REQUESTS TO THE NEW CONGRESS LARGELY TO IMPROVEMENT IN, AND MODIFICATIONS OF, EXISTING GREAT SOCIETY PROGRAMS.

AN EASTERN AIRLINES PLANE WITH 109 PERSONS ABOARD REPORTED LANDING GEAR TROUBLE TODAY AS IT WAS NEARING MEXICO CITY. THE PLANE--ON A FLIGHT FROM NEW YORK--CIRCLED THE MEXICO CITY AIRPORT FOR MORE THAN ONE HOUR TO EXHAUST ITS FUEL BEFORE TRYING AN EMERGENCY LANDING. BUT THE PILOT WAS FINALLY ABLE TO LOWER THE LANDING GEAR AND MAKE A NORMAL LANDING.

HAVANA RADIO REPORTS CUBAN SECURITY TROOPS AND COAST GUARDS HAVE FRUSTRATED AN ATTEMPT BY FIVE MEN TO SMUGGLE 20 PERSONS OUT OF CUBA BY BOAT TO MIAMI, FLORIDA. THE BROADCAST REFERRED TO THE FIVE WHO CAME FROM FLORIDA WITH THE BOAT AS PIRATES. IT SAID ONE WAS KILLED AND FOUR CAPTURED. THE 20 CUBANS WHO HOPED TO FLEE FROM COMMUNIST RULE ALSO WERE REPORTED TAKEN INTO CUSTODY. HAVANA RADIO SAID THE LEADER OF THE CAPTURED PIRATES WAS A CUBAN REFUGEE NAMED ENRIQUE GONZALEZ, KNOWN AS "THE THIN ONE"

A VICIOUS SNOW STORM OVERTOOK TEN MEN WHO CLIMBED 13,000-FOOT GRAND TETON PEAK IN NORTHWESTERN WYOMING NEW YEAR'S EVE, AND THEY HAD NOT BEEN HEARD FROM. BUT TWO OF THEM REACHED SAFETY WEDNESDAY NIGHT IN MOOSE, WYOMING. AND THEY REPORTED THE OTHER EIGHT ALSO ARE SAFE--CAMPED AT BRADLEY LAKE--AND WILL HIKE TO THE VALLEY FLOOR TOMORROW.

MOSCOW RADIO SAYS THERE HAS BEEN A MAJOR EARTHQUAKE IN NORTHERN MONGOLIA. EARLIER, OBSERVATORIES IN BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA AND TOKYO HAD REPORTED THE QUAKE, DESCRIBING IT AS A MAJOR UNHEAVAL. MOSCOW GAVE NO IMMEDIATE REPORT ON WHETHER THE QUAKE HIT A POPULATED AREA.

THE WEATHER BUREAU REPORTS A SNOWSTORM IS MOVING ACROSS THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST TOWARD THE NORTHERN ROCKY MOUNTAINS. FOUR INCHES OF SNOW HAS FALLEN AT SEATTLE. ANOTHER STORM IS SPREADING A FRESH BLANKET OF SNOW OVER THE MIDWEST. IN THE EAST, AN OFFSHORE LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM IS SPREADING SNOW OR COLD RAIN INLAND TO THE APPALACHIANS.

FORMER PRESIDENT EISENHOWER AND HIS WIFE MAMIE HAVE BOARDED A PRIVATE RAILROAD CAR IN HARRISBURG, PENN TO DEPART FOR THEIR ANNUAL WINTER VACATION AT PALM DESERT, CALIF. EISENHOWER UNDERWENT SURGERY FOR REMOVAL OF HIS GALL BLADDER LAST MONTH. HE APPEARED HEALTHY AND SMILING AS HE BOARDED THE TRAIN. THE EISENHOWERS ARE DUE IN PALM SPRINGS ON SATURDAY MORNING.

UNIONIZED PLUMBERS IN NEW YORK CITY HAVE RATIFIED AN AGREEMENT WHICH WILL END A 164-DAY STRIKE THAT HAS HELD UP 600 MILLION DOLLARS WORTH OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION. A HIGH OFFICIAL OF THE AFL-CIO PLUMBERS UNION SAID THE MEN WILL REPORT FOR WORK THURSDAY MORNING. THE TENTATIVE CONTRACT WOULD GIVE THE PLUMBERS AN INCREASE OF \$1.30 AN HOUR. THIS BRINGS THEIR PAY TO \$8.59 AN HOUR OF \$68.72 FOR AN EIGHT-HOUR DAY.

A 32-YEAR OLD JOBLESS LONDONER HAS BEEN ARRESTED AND CHARGED WITH STEALING EIGHT OLD MASTER PAINTINGS FROM THE DULWICH COLLEGE ART GALLERY. THE PAINTINGS, INCLUDING THREE BY RUBENS AND THREE BY REMBRANDT, HAVEN BEEN RECOVERED, ALMOST ENTIRELY FREE OF DAMAGE.

  - (c) Underway time will be 0930 both days - the ship will return to E.B. Wed PM and to the USN Underwater Sound Lab on Thur PM. Busses will be waiting at YWSE to take the Gold Crew and dependents back to the parking lot behind the Supervisor of Shipbuilding Thursday.
  - (d) Guests and dependents are to be on board by 0900 on the applicable day. Liberty will expire for the members of the host crew at 0730. The manuevering watch will be stationed at 0830. Lifelines will be left rigged.
